Re: Pupil Premium funding to support Year 11 Revision

As you may be aware Pupil Premium is funding received from the government in addition to the school's budget. It is targeted at students who have received free schools meals in the last 6 years, students from a forces background or 'looked after' students, to help them achieve more in their academic and social lives. Schools are free to decide how to allocate this funding to raise the attainment of the students in receipt of this benefit.

St Luke's has decided that an amount of the funding received for the 2015/2016 academic year will be allocated to support the individual needs of each Pupil Premium student. Therefore I am pleased to advise that money has been made available to support the revision needs of all Year 11 Pupil Premium students.

The funding can be claimed from the College to support the purchase of revision guides and materials recommended by the curriculum departments. Departments will recommend materials over the following months in the lead up to the final examination period in May.
