As we move in to the final half term, it is essential that we maintain our very highest standards and so I would like to bring your attention to a few matters which we ask for your support on. Firstly with respect to uniform, please ensure that your son/daughter comes to school each day looking smart and wearing the correct uniform. It is not appropriate for any student to be wearing jeans, leggings or jeggings but instead should be wearing school trousers or a skirt of appropriate length. Shoes should be black and non-marked and all students should be wearing a blazer and tie. We are extremely proud of our uniform and expect that every student wears it correctly each day. In addition I refer to our jewellery policy and remind parents that only one pair of ear studs is allowed and as such students should not be wearing any additional ear piercings or other facial piercings.



Being punctual and on time is another crucial aspect of our school day and again I remind parents that our first bell rings at 8.40am. Every student should be in College at this time and ready to move on to their tutorial session.



Finally, we ask for your continued co-operation with respect to the collection of students at the end of the day. We are experiencing very challenging situations in the car park at the close of the day which often leads to students who require medical transport not being collected on time or having difficulty in accessing their support vehicles.
