Dear Parent/Carer/Pupil,

RE: St Luke's Science and Sports College "Multi Sports Day" 2013

On Tuesday 16th July 2013, St Luke's Science and Sports College will be holding our "Multi Sports Day". The event will be held on-site and will run to normal school hours, with *students required in school by 8.45am* and being released at 3.10pm. They should arrive already wearing correct St Luke's PE kit, no jewellery and with hair-tied back securely (if longer than jaw length), and assemble for registration in their Houses at the following assembly points:

- Darwin = Year10/11 outdoor seating area
- Franklin = Outside of old student reception area by art.
- Galileo = Amphitheatre
- Rutherford = On the grass outside of DT.

In addition to their PE kit and trainers, students are required to bring:

- A tracksuit or other warm over-clothing for when not competing
- A waterproof jacket
- Suntan lotion and hat
- **A packed lunch and plenty of fluids** (Students that are eligible for a free school lunch should collect their packed lunch from the PE area at lunchtime.)

It should be noted that **the canteen will not be providing food on Sports Day**, therefore all students will need to bring a packed lunch. There will be ice cream and coffee sellers on school site. This service should be seen as supplementary to the students packed lunches and **not** instead of!

Access to the school building will be restricted all day and as such students should *not* assume access to their lockers. Students will be required to keep their belongings safe and with them at all times and as we are unable to take responsibility for your child's personal possessions, we request that you ensure they do not bring expensive items, jewellery or large sums of money with them to college.

As always, any parents/carers wishing to cheer on their child at Sport day are welcome to do so. However to ensure site security, we request that you arrive no earlier than 9.15 am, through the main car park and enter via the steps at the left-hand side of the building (near the Sports Hall and Tennis Courts). Here you will be required to sign in/out, acknowledging the students you are here to support, and to wear an official visitor's sticker visible on your clothing at all times. You will not be permitted access into the college building, except the Sports Hall to watch an event, however there will be a Staff and Parent Toilet accessible from outside throughout the day and refreshments from 11 am 'til 1.30pm.

We have our fingers crossed for fine weather, as Multi Sports Day will go ahead rain or shine and look forward to a fantastic, fun-filled event.
