

Uniform Clarification

We have had a few students who are wearing clothing that some local retailers are describing as 'school uniform' but is not acceptable at St. Luke's.

To help clarify matters we have worked with our school uniform partner, Thomas Moores. We have agreed the appropriate styles for our College and will guide parents to these in their store.

If parents choose to use other sources they should ensure that the uniform meets our uniform list and the clarification below.

1. School Trousers and Skirts.

Working with our uniform partner – Thomas Moores we have identified several appropriate pairs of trousers and skirts that are correct uniform. These are formally tailored and are not of canvas or denim style materials.



2. School Shoes

These should be of a formal style, have an enclosed toe and be of leather or leather effect. Any shoe that has canvas or fabric as part of its design is not correct uniform. Boots are not allowed. The only colour visible should be black and there should be no logos or motifs.
