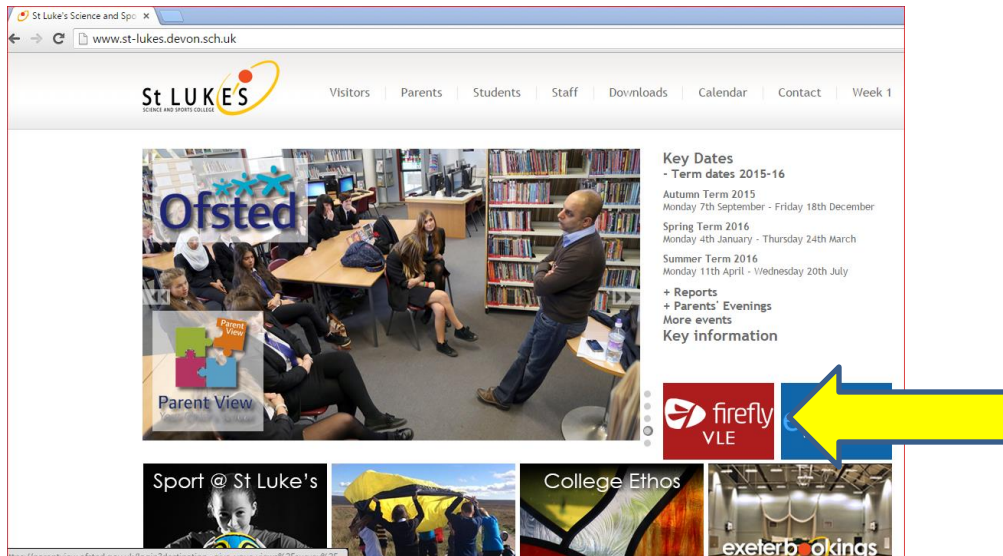
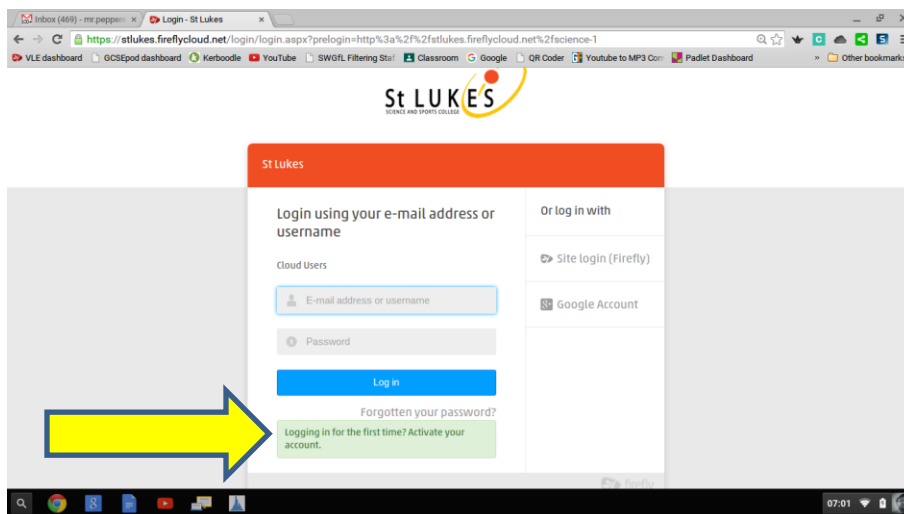


Firefly VLE User Guide for Parents

The VLE can be accessed from our home page www.st-lukes.devon.sch.uk by clicking on the red Firefly VLE button.

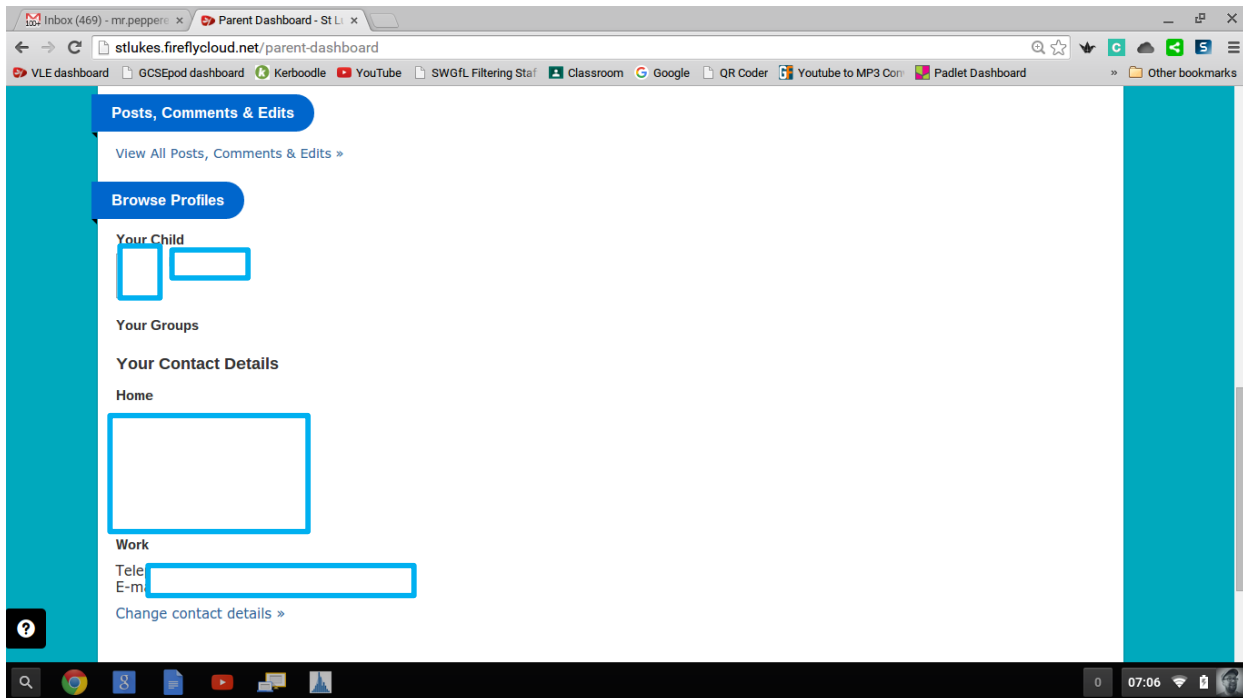
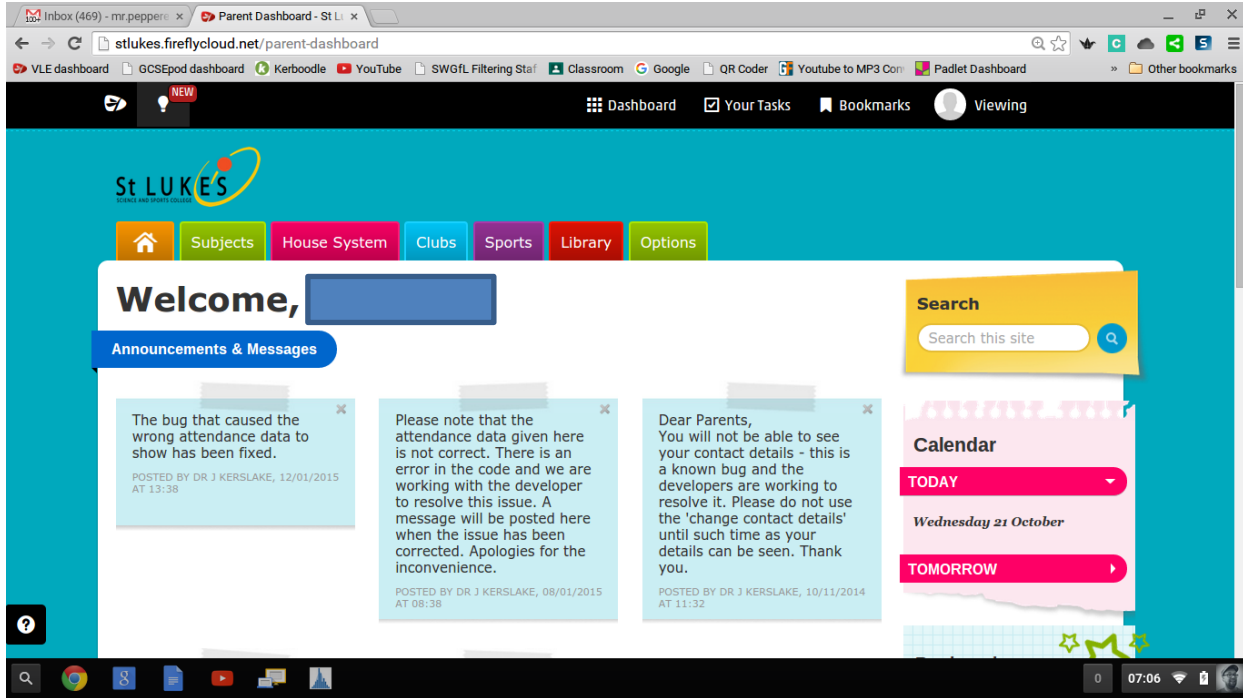


Then click on the green section that says "Logging in for the first time? Activate your account". Click and enter the email address which you supplied to the school.



This will generate a password which will be sent to your email address. You will then be able to login to the VLE.

After you login you will be taken to the dashboard. From here you can view messages from staff, check your contact details and have links to your child/children.



By clicking through your child's name, you will be able to see a student summary which gives information on their timetable, simple attendance and homework/tasks which have been set, along with feedback on previous tasks. You will also be able to view your child's reports.
